We're here to help you live independently and support your goals in life. Whether that means a little bit of help around your house, or 24/7 support, we can help with personal care, household chores, cooking and much more.

We will help you explore your options and get you to where you want to be.

Learn

Whatever your goals – for life, for work and for you personally – we collaborate with you to identify the skills and knowledge you need to achieve them. Working with you, we will design your learning program and support team to help you reach your potential.

Work

We have a range of employment and training options designed to help you reach your goals and find a job you love. With real jobs in a social and supportive environment, we can help you figure out what you want to do and the skills you'll need to get there.

Live

If your goal is to live independently, we can work with you to get there. Get support within your own home, or within an Endeavour Foundation property.

Supported Independent Living

Supported Independent Living (SIL) is the support NDIS participants receive to help them live as independently as possible. SIL was formerly known as supported accommodation.

How we can support you

Housing options

We offer a range of home options to help you maximise your independence. Most of our homes are centrally located and close to public transport, shops, and community facilities.

Qualified support staff

We are passionate about providing person-centred and active support to ensure you live in a safe and happy home.

We listen to your needs to develop a roster of qualified support staff that can drop in to provide support, or be on hand 24/7.

Engage with your community

We help match you with the right housemates so you can make lifelong friends. We also encourage you to be involved within your community, build an active social life, get out and about, and have fun!

Build life skills

We support you to develop important daily living skills to live independently, such as learning how to maintain a clean and safe home, personal care, budgeting, and social skills.

In-Home Support

Whether you are living in your own home or private rental, our support team can offer individualised support within your home, tailored to your goals.

Get access to support that meets your circumstances and expectations, from gaining independence in the kitchen to getting out and about.

Whether it's developing practical life skills like cooking, budgeting or getting work ready – we're here to help you flourish according to your own interests and priorities.

Community Participation

Being connected to our communities and social networks contributes to our sense of wellbeing, purpose and quality of life. If you're keen to try a new activity, make new friends or just to get out and about, Community Participation is for you.

Get individualised support to engage with the local community. We work with you to understand your individual needs including your likes, dislikes and the goals you want to achieve.

Work

Work can provide you with a sense of purpose. We're passionate about finding opportunities for you to build on your strengths and gain the skills, confidence and experience to find a job you love. We offer pathways to both supported and mainstream employment.

Supported employment

Supported employment is employment that has been designed for people with disability. It's great for people who need more support than what is available in a traditional workplace, or as a supportive first job when transitioning out of school.

We offer supported employment opportunities for people with disability through our social enterprises, where you will have the opportunity to gain new skills, be part of a team and earn an income.

Mainstream employment

Mainstream employment is a term that is used when someone with disability works in a mainstream workforce, alongside employees without disability.

If you want to increase your independence, earn your own money and connect with the community, mainstream employment might be the right option for you.

We provide guidance and ongoing support to people with disability to pursue their mainstream employment goals.
