If you are thinking about moving out of your family home and into your own place, we can help. We provide in-home assistance ranging from support 24 hours a day, to assistance with personal care, household tasks and mealtimes. We will help you explore your options and get you to where you want to be.

Whatever your goals – for life, for work and for you personally – we collaborate with you to identify the skills and knowledge you need to achieve them. Working with you we will design your learning program to help you reach your potential.

Work

What is Supported Independent Living?

Supported Independent Living (SIL) is the support NDIS participants receive to help them live as independently as possible. SIL was formerly known as supported accommodation.

Engage with your community

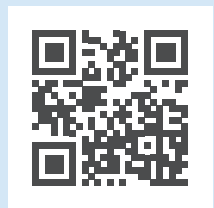
We help you find the right match with housemates so you can make lifelong friends. We also encourage you to be involved within your community, build an active social life, get out and about, and have fun!

Work

Work can provide you with a sense of purpose, an opportunity to gain skills and improve confidence and self-esteem.

At Endeavour Foundation, we focus on what you can do, your strengths and your capabilities. We believe meaningful employment is an important part of an inclusive, empowering community.

We offer employment options designed to help you reach your goals and find a job you love.

Supported employment

Supported employment is employment that has been designed for people with disability. It's great for people who need more support than what is available in a traditional workplace, or as a supportive first job when transitioning out of school.

We offer supported employment opportunities for people with intellectual disability through our Business Solutions sites where you will have the opportunity to gain new skills, be part of a team and earn an income.

Open employment

Open employment is a term that is often used when someone with disability works in a mainstream workforce, alongside employees without disability.

At Endeavour Foundation, we offer Supported Independent Employment – it's open employment with support. This means that we provide guidance and ongoing support to people with intellectual disability to pursue their open employment goals.
