1. Assistive technology

If you need support with mobility, communication, sensory regulation and more, the NDIS can fund various assistive technology devices. Assistive technology is designed to increase your independence.

2. Specialised Driver Training

Keen to get your driver's licence? The NDIS can fund Specialised Driver Training to help you reach this goal and gain confidence in navigating roads independently.

3. Vehicle modifications

If you are armed with your driver's licence and require modifications to your vehicle to ensure it is safe and accessible, get in touch with the NDIS to enquire about funding.

4. Supported Employment

If you are unable to prepare meals yourself and do not have other supports available to you, the NDIS can assist with the cost of preparation and delivery of meals – but not the food itself.

7. Group activities

Interested in joining group activities in the community and/or at a dedicated place? The NDIS can deliver funding to support you with this aim.

8. Supported Independent Living (SIL)

If you are unable to live on your own and require 24/7 support, SIL might be an option for you. The NDIS can fund 24/7 support at different ratios, depending on your needs.

9. In-Home Support

If you have a home and can live without 24/7 support, but need help with daily tasks, the NDIS can fund a support worker to come to your home and support you with relevant activities.

10. Assistance with accommodation and tenancy obligations

Looking to live independently and need support with obtaining housing and/or meeting the obligations of your tenancy agreement? The NDIS can provide funding, as long as the need for support is linked to your disability.
