## Looking After a Pet Cat – Note Taking

In this activity you are required to read the information below about looking after a pet cat. Your task is to take notes (key facts that you have learned) on the template provided.

## Looking After a Pet Cat – Information

The best place for cats to live is indoors. They will be safe and will be less likely to be injured in car accidents, catch diseases and fight with other cats.

There are many ways to make sure your cat is happy living indoors. Provide plenty of toys for them to play e.g. boxes, balls, tunnels, furry toys. Cats need a scratching post to sharpen their claws and a comfortable bed to sleep in. A litter tray that is kept clean is also important.

Cats are easy to feed. Feed your cat high quality cat food appropriate for their stage in life. They may also like raw meat and raw meaty bones. Many human foods will make a cat sick so avoid feeding your cat these (e.g. avocado, chocolate, coffee etc.) Cats need fresh water daily.

Cats do not usually need to be washed – they are very good at keeping themselves clean. Brush their fur regularly to avoid fur balls and clip their nails every 3 weeks.

Finally, treat your cat with respect. Cats love company and play time but can also be very independent. Acknowledge this and love and accept their personality.
