We are committed to delivering culturally safe supports and services to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and young people, including supporting them to connect with culture, family and country, when that is their choice.

Endeavour Foundation supports and respects all children and young people and their supporters. We are committed to providing an inclusive environment, particularly for children and young people with a disability.

We commit to a culture of openness and safety where children and young people are encouraged to talk freely when they feel unsafe or worried, to appropriate adults. We support children, young people and their families to actively participate in decisions that affect their lives.
