**Join a day program where people come together to focus on creativity, confidence and fun. The Drama Ensemble program is held each Wednesday at the Endeavour Foundation Learning and Lifestyle Hub in Lawnton.**

Throughout the program people will learn new life skills or work on personal goals like:

- ★ building social and communication skills
- ★ increased confidence and comfort expressing ideas and feelings
- ★ safe ways to explore and manage emotions
- ★ creativity and problem-solving through drama and role-play
- ★ improved movement, coordination and body awareness
- ★ a sense of belonging, pride and shared achievement

The program includes co-writing and performing a story for a live audience. Stories may include movement, dance, singing, songwriting, and playwriting, depending on the performers' interest and confidence. No acting or drama experience is needed.

The program is led by an experienced Creative Director, Clark Crystal. Clark is a Brisbane-based theatre director with many years' experience working in inclusive and community theatre works with people with disability. Clark's approach focuses on recognising each person's abilities, building confidence, and supporting self-expression through creativity.
